**2012 Scholarship Application Criteria and Procedures for**  
**Undergraduate/Graduate Military Spouses**

**Awards**

The Vandenberg Spouses' Club will award scholarships to eligible spouses who show promise of contributing to their communities. The Scholarship Selection Committee considers an applicant's community service, special interests, talent and exceptional qualifications. Financial need will not be a consideration.

**Eligibility**

Spouses of active duty assigned to Vandenberg AFB, and retired or deceased military are eligible if applicant resides in either Santa Barbara County, CA or San Luis Obispo County, CA. Current members and relatives of current members of the VSC Board, scholarship committee, and scholarship judging committee are not eligible to receive the scholarship. The selection process will not discriminate on the bases of age, race, color, national origin, ethnic group or gender. *Prior Spouses Club winners are not eligible.*

**Limitations**

Scholarships are not limited to any specific field of study and may be used as a full time student or part time student at any accredited vocational, technical school, college or university. Scholarships must be claimed by **01 May 2013**, and used for tuition and books during the 2012-2013 school years. Payment of scholarship monies will be made directly to the selected school upon request and all monies will stay in an account until used in full. Spouses accepting any other full school scholarship (tuition, room and board) become ineligible for this award. In this event, the scholarship will be awarded to a chosen alternate.

**Application Package must contain:**

1. Complete Application
2. Complete the attached Applicant Information Form

**In addition, attach the following items to your application package:**

3. 3 letters of recommendation (from chaplains, teachers, employers, etc. NOT a parent/relative)
4. A photocopy of Military ID front and back.

**In lieu of an essay you will be scheduled for a short discussion of your personal growth in education and your role as a military spouse. The date for this is *tentatively* set for April 19, 2012.**

***For scholarship consideration, all packages must contain items 1-4 submitted no later than March 30, 2012 to address listed on page 1.***

<b>Type of Activity</b>	<b>Description</b>
<u>Honors and Awards</u>	Include any recognition you have received as a result of academic or extracurricular activities.
<u>School and Community</u>	Provide details of any post high school education. Also, list any volunteer activities: service to school, the base, your community or church. Include approximate time involved in each activity. Specify leadership responsibilities and/or offices held for each organization.
<u>Employment</u>	Provide employer and number of hours worked each week. This includes those who are self employed, day care providers and/or stay-at-home parents.
